MULTI-CHILD DISCOUNT

First child registered is full-price. A 10% discount will be applied to the camp fees for all additional children residing in the same household.

PAYMENT FOR CAMP FEES

Below are the three payment options:

- Monthly Bank Draft: Payments will be set up in three installments of \$300 for Members or \$350 for Community on May 1, June 1, and July 1.
- Bi-Weekly Bank Draft: Payments will be set up in six bi-weekly installments of \$150 for Members or \$175 for Community on the following dates:
 - May 13 & 27
 - June 10 & 24
 - July 8 & 22
- Third Party Pay: Safari, Voyage, and Quest are licensed Child Care Programs and accept third party assistance. The provider **must be switched** to our Burlington Area YMCA Child Care center prior to the start of camp. (Child Care Center: Provider #19899)



CAMP CANDY

For those that do not qualify for third party assistance, Safari, Voyage, and Quest participants can sell camp candy to earn their way to camp! Candy can be sold from March 14 -April 29 Candy will be available for you to check out beginning on March 14 at 9:00am. All fundraising participants must register for camp prior to selling the candy. 50% of the proceeds will be applied to camp.

WHAT TO WEAR

Campers will spend time outdoors. Children must wear appropriate clothing and foot wear. No sandals or flip flops. (May bring on swim days) Sunscreen should be applied before camp and brought to camp as well. The Y will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.



We will be participating in the Food Program. Your child will receive breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack daily, included in your total program fee.

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CAMP MCBRIDE THEME DISCRPTIONS

SESSION 1: WACKY SCIENCE & MAGIC JUNE 6-10 (AGES 5-12)
