ON MARCH 6, 2023**

WEEKLY SESSIONS

Sessions run Monday through Friday from 9:00am-4:00pm. At 9:00am each morning transportation will be provided from the YMCA to camp by bus. ****Parents must physically put their child(ren) on the bus. Early drop off is not permitted, unless your camper is registered for the extended care program.** The campers will be returned to the Y at approximately 4:20pm. Parents are responsible for their child(ren) when they get off the bus. Children who are not picked up from the bus will be taken to the extended care program and parents will be charged \$20. The camp fee includes all program costs, a sack lunch daily, \$5.00 credit to MoMo's Store and a Y-camp t-shirt. If for some reason your child is unable to attend the week of camp he/she is registered for, notice of the cancellation must be communicated through the Directors, Lindsey Koopmans or Zoelle Simmons, by the Monday prior to the week he/she is scheduled to attend. Failure to do so will result in the remaining camp fee being non-refundable. Children need to bring an afternoon snack, water bottle, swimsuit and towel, sunscreen and tennis shoes every day (NO SANDALS). Please mark all of your child's belongings. On Tuesday and Wednesday the campers tie-dye. Send a white shirt if your child would like to participate.



CAMP ACTIVITIES

The camp program provides the perfect opportunity to experience a wide range of amazing activities for both old and new campers. Each week is scheduled individually. Camper activities will include: Hiking, Swimming, Arts & Crafts, Singing, Skits, Archery, Nature Study, Air-Riflery, Boating, Group Games, Water Games, Youth Sports, Obstacle Courses, GAGA and weekly theme activities.

EARN YOUR WAY TO CAMP FUNDRAISER

Looking for a way to send your child to camp? Candy can be sold from March 6-April 26. Candy will be available for check out beginning on March 6 at 9:00am. All fundraising participants must register for camp prior to selling the candy. 50% of the proceeds will be applied to camp fees. If you sell more candy than what is required to pay your camp fees, the remainder will be donated to the YMCA Campership Program. Candy sales cannot be transferred to another camper or carried over to the following year.

LEADERS IN TRAINING / JR COUNSELOR

A two-week Mon-Fri training opportunity for teenagers. The Leader in Training (LIT) program includes traditional camp activities, leadership and group dynamics training. LIT is for campers 6th grade through 14 years of age. Normal camp fees apply. If campers have passed the two week LIT program, they are eligible to sign up to be a Junior Counselor (JC). CAMP MCBRIDE MOMO'S STORE

Items available at Momo's Store will include snacks, trinkets, flavored water and more! Momo's Store will be open Mon-Fri after swim time until 3:45p.m. Each child will receive \$5 credit to be used toward the purchase of store merchandise. This initial credit can only be spent at Momo's Store, with any remaining credit balance going to the campership fund. EXTENDED HOURS / FEE

For working parents, campers may be brought to the Y Monday-Friday as early as 7:00am and picked up as late as 5:30pm. In the mornings you need to drop your child off in the Youth Zone. Children can be picked up in the Youth Zone or on the playground. You need to sign your child in and out. Extended care passes must be purchased at the front desk and presented to the staff prior to the child attending. **\$20 per week.** (A late pick up fee of \$5.00 per 5 minutes will be charged to parents who do not pick their child up by 5:30pm).



**SESSION 1: BLOWING OFF STEAM
JUNE 5-9 (AGES 5-12)**

Come and explore fun science experiments . This week Campers will learn about pop rock science, build and launch miniature catapults, take a trip to the moon with alka selzer rockets, build and play paper airplane golf, and build an explosive volcano. This week is going to be Science Overload!

**SESSION 2: CARNIVAL
JUNE 12-16 (AGES 5-12)**

**SESSION 4: ADVENTURES UNLIMITED
JUNE 26-30 (AGES 5-12)**

During this fun filled week, campers will compete to win prizes. Campers will enjoy scavenger hunts, team challenges, tug of war competitions, a relay race, jump rope games and obstacle courses. Let the FUN begin!

**SESSION 5: DISNEY/SUPERHERO
JULY 3-7 (NO 4TH) (AGES 5-7)**

Campers will discover their superpowers and use them to rescue the princesses from the evil villain! JULY 10-14 (AGES 5-12)**

JULY 17-21 (AGES 5-12)**

**SESSION 8: WET & WILD

To register, complete the form below and return it with a \$30 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit per session. All camp fees must be paid in full by the MONDAY PRIOR to your child's first day of that session. All sessions are filled on a first come, first serve basis. If your child's fees are not paid by the Monday prior to the first day of the session, your child will be unable to attend.
